Your Beatitude, our beloved Brother-in-Christ
Catholicos Mor Baselios Thomas I, Your Eminences
our Beloved Metropolitans, Very Rev. Corepiscopos
and Rambachans, Reverend Priests and Deacons,
Devoted Nuns and our beloved spiritual children.

We are very happy to be with you here today. This
church in the name of St. John the Baptist has a very
important place in the history of our Holy Syrian
Orthodox Church in India. In the Nineteen Seventies,
when the faith and the existence of our Holy Church in
India were in question, this parish was in the forefront
in defending the true apostolic faith and traditions of our
